

Mora/San Miguel & Farm & Livestock Bureau 2022 Scholarship Application Form

The Mora/San Miguel County Farm & Livestock Bureau will be awarding one (1) scholarship to a Mora or San Miguel high school senior in May.

Scholarship Rules & Requirements:

1. The applicant must be a resident of either Mora County or San Miguel County. The applicants or families do not have to be members of Mora San/Miguel Farm and Livestock Bureau, but preference will be given to an applicant whose family are members.
2. The applicant must be a high school senior or home schooled senior in good academic standing.
3. The scholarship shall be awarded once a year.
4. The scholarship shall be applied to any college, university, trade or vocational school.
5. The scholarship will be payable either directly to the college, university, trade or vocation school at the discretion of the Mora/San Miguel Farm & Livestock Bureau for expenses such as tuition, books, fees, or room and board.
6. All applicants will be identified by a number and the names will be withheld until after a recipient has been selected by the scholarship committee.
7. **All application forms must be typewritten or computer generated.** Supplements (descriptions of school & community activities and essays) should be typed. **Illegible applications will not be accepted.**

8. All applicants will be judged on a 100-point scale. The scale is as follows:

- GPA 5 pts
- School Activities, Club and Honors 15 pts
- Community Activities and Organizations 5 pts
- Essay #1 30 pts
- Essay #2 25 pts
- Financial Need 10 pt
- Judge's Discretion 10 pts

9. An official transcript (no photo copy) of the applicant's school record provided by the high school must accompany the application.
